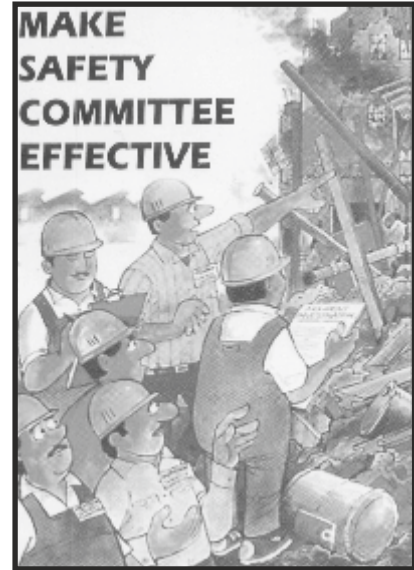

## Program

Occupational hazards and unsafe work environment pose risk of injuries and ill health to workers. This would adversely affect the morale and motivation of the workers and in turn would adversely affect their productivity. The industry cannot afford this in the competitive market in the era of globalization where use of new manufacturing technologies and hazardous chemicals in industry is increasing the potential risk of occupation hazards.

The scope for trade union is unlimited to make extensive contribution in promoting safety and health in industry through commitment and constructive approach. It is impossible to improve safety and health standards without the involvement of workers. There have been many attempts to involve workers through consultation. The most successful method is through Trade Union Representatives. The participation of Trade Unions in the process of safety and health in the safety committees makes the work environment safe.

Recognising the important role of Trade Unions and Workers in occupational safety and health, a statutory provision was incorporated in The Factories Act, 1948.

The Factories Act, 1948 ensures setting up of Safety Committee in factories for workers' participation and co-operation with the management in occupational safety and health management. The State Factories Rules under provision of the Factories Act, have laid down the structure, right, role and functioning of the Safety Committee with responsibility.

## Objectives

The course will provide a unique opportunity for the participants to understand their problems relating to occupational safety and health. At the end of the course the participants would be in a position to clearly describe their role and effectively guide the workers in promoting safety and health at the work place.

## Topics

- Worker's Participation in Safety Management - Structure, Role and Function of safety committee.
- Role of Trade Union in Promoting Safety and Health at Work Place.
- Behavior based Safety and Motivation.
- Basic Principles of Accident Prevention.
- Manual Material Handling.
- Role & Responsibilities of Safety Committee Members - Group Exercises.
- Prevention of occupational health hazards
- Health and hygiene at work places

The topics will be presented through lectures and discussions and supported by case studies and films.
